RE: COVID-19 UPDATE

Dear Residents, Associates, Families of Woods:

On Monday November 15<sup>th</sup>, 2021, Woods received notification that one of the registry nurses who has worked in the past seven days at Woods had tested positive for Covid19, although fully vaccinated. Due to the fact that this nurse worked in all areas of Woods we are assigning the entire facility as “Yellow Zone”, which means there has been an exposure for residents and associates and so we will be returning to the guidelines we had in place previously however due to new guidance visitation may continue however full PPE will be required by anyone who is within six feet of a resident or entering a resident room. Visitation may occur out of doors without full PPE.

Residents at Woods may go “out on pass” for the Thanksgiving Holiday with a physician’s order.

For the next two weeks we will be testing all associates and residents of Woods each week for the virus. In addition, residents will remain in their rooms, for dining, activities, and therapy. All associates and most residents at Woods have been fully vaccinated.

We will be monitoring all associates and residents for symptoms. We ask for your patience during this time. Friendly, our Life Enrichment Coordinator will be facilitating virtual visits with loved ones and Nicole our Social Worker will be arranging for virtual doctor’s visits in coordination with family and the physician’s office.

We will be in touch with and getting additional guidance from the Los Angeles Department of Public Health and will communicate any changes in protocol as appropriate.
